## Dissemination strategy

At the COOPEUS annual meeting in Helsinki the following dissemination tasks were prioritized; In the current meeting at AGU, the Status of the tasks were reported and new initiatives determined.

- ✓ **Booth at AGU w. Flyer + iLEAPS mags etc.** - At the AGU2014 meeting COOPEUS hosted a booth with COOPEUS flyers and other information about our activities. The iLEAPS magazine was finalized and also handed out at the booth along with information from partner RIs and COOPEUS merchandise.
- ✓ **Commentary in High-end Journal** – H. Loescher (NEON) has submitted a commentary article to *Nature Climate Change* regarding the need for improved interoperability among RIs. *The COOPEUS scope and activities are specifically mentioned in this article.* Furthermore, COOPEUS is involved in the springer book project on Emergent Environmental Observatories led by NEON
- **Events at larger Conferences – At the EGU2015**, COOPEUS will hold the 3<sup>rd</sup> workshop in the COOPEUS roadmap workshop-series. The meeting will be held at a venue outside the conference center in order to make it available for participants who are not registered for the EGU conference.  
**An EGU2015 COOPEUS Booth** was suggested; Experiences from other project regarding having a booth were positive. Sorvari (FMI) suggested a joint ENVRI-COOPEUS booth. Action to be taken by FMI for the organization of booth of COOPEUS/ENVRI booth.
- **Webinar:** J. Pearlman gave a presentation on the possibilities for making a COOPEUS webinar and moderated the following discussion.

A webinar session will be planned for conduction and recording at EGU2015. Recording in front of a selected invited audience consisting of VIPs in the infrastructure circles .  
Target audience: larger RI community including data providers, data users and Funding agencies as well as new RI members of COOPEUS.  
Form: Panel 3 VIPs : 1 EU COOPEUS representative; 1 US representative; 1 invited expert.

Overall theme: revolving around the overall scope of COOPEUS specifics TBC (*“The COOPEUS mission is to facilitate readily accessible research infrastructure data to advance our understanding of Earth systems through an international community-driven effort, by: Bringing together both user communities and top-down directives to address evolving societal and scientific needs; Removing technical, scientific, cultural and geopolitical barriers for data use; and Coordinating the flow, integrity and preservation of information.”*)

We might have 3 themes right here.

- 1) *Bringing together both user communities and top-down directives to address evolving societal and scientific needs;*
- 2) *Removing technical, scientific, cultural and geopolitical barriers for data use*
- 3) *Coordinating the flow, integrity and preservation of information*

## **Funding (SAVI, COOP+, other)**

COOP+ was submitted and is under evaluation. Currently, no news on the status of the application. Jesus Marco (CSIC) will inform us when there is news to be reported.

A new SAVI proposal is coming up; more planning within the US-steering committee

## **Formal partnerships (Powers)**

L Powers (NEON) will pursue COOPEUS partnerships/membership/official association with world leading data societies and organizations, such as the ICSU WDS and other.

The COOPEUS partner representatives agreed that Chris Lenhardt (SCB chair) will have status as an official signatory for COOPEUS.
